Paul. Thank You for taking my call on Nov. 7th, 2011 in reference to the Small Wibling building next door to our current property, Conanicut Aviation at 49 Miry Brook Rd. I and the owner of Conanicut Aviation are in contract talks with the Wibling family to purchase the property and building next to our property. We believe and will review the plot plan, that the building and property has airport access. There are currently 4 unofficial helicopter landing blocks painted in the area of the property that we currently own and if we purchase the remaining property from the Wiblings, will occupy the remaining spot area's.

My concern at the moment is that Executive air traverses over our property to park helicopters and use the area as described for all types of operations and in the near future when Centennial helicopters, a long time tenant and of Executive air service (Past 3 owners and operators) leaves to expand and build with the new operation of Wesconn LLC, that EAS will start to use the area owned by the town of Danbury at there leisure. This will cause blockage and open liability to the town and inconvenient to Conanicut Aviation LLC.

At this time I would like to inform the airport and administration that Conanicut Aviation and Independent Aviation Inc. has a direct interest in the Wibling building and request first consideration to lease whatever property is still owned in and around the Helicopter pads as discussed that will be in close proximity to owned land from these companies.
