Continued discussion regarding Ward reconfiguration and reapportionment:

- Riefberg commented on an earlier Plan submittal, for the record, that he was not in favor of a substantial “overhaul” and that he would be in support of maintaining within appropriate deviation, the present overall Ward structure.
- Walkovich offered a Plan that would reconfigure Wards in a manner that would represent the following goals:
 1. As close to a zero population deviation as possible
 2. No Ward disruption
 3. Maintain incumbents in districts/wards
 4. More downtown representation
- King offered a Plan also adjusting in accordance with stated goals, and with minimal deviation from the norm. Proposal would also try and address the Broadview voting precinct issue.

MOTION by Riefberg, second Walkovich to offer Walkovich proposed Plan. Discussion ensued and remained open regarding details within, which discussion is to be continued on September 19th, with a final motion to recommend to the City Council, once Joe and Michael connected on some final “Plan” points.
