Regina turned the meeting over to Jack for his update. WestConn presented a "Science at Night" seminar open to the public, which Jack attended. Enviro Science was one of the presenters. After listening to their presentation Jack concluded that the milfoil weevil use is still experimental. The suction harvesting occurred and was successful. The contractor covered twice as much area as last time we did this. The work on the buffer garden has not begun, and we have limited options to get Reliable to begin their work. Jack tried to get the purchase order approved to hire Camilla, but the City again froze new purchase orders, as of June 1.

Jack has been working with two WestConn graduate students to design the baseline study for the WCSU grant work. He then did a presentation on this baseline study.

Jack presented the following projects and goals:

- Weed treatment
- Publicize completion of the vegetative buffer
- Public outreach
- Fund raising
- Explore in-lake treatments

A motion was made, seconded, and passed to rehire Jack as our advisor for the upcoming fiscal year.
