

**Post 1983 Pension Board Meeting Minutes**  
**September 10, 2013**

The Post 1983 Pension Board met on September 10, 2013, at approximately 4:20 P.M. Board members in attendance were Finance Director David St. Hilaire, Lieutenant McColgan, Detective Lieutenant Williams, Phil Curran and Detective Hicks. Other persons in attendance were Assistant Corporation Council Attorney Dianne Rosemark, Animal Control Officer Charles Farrar, and Mrs. Natalie Farrar.

1) The Board voted unanimously in favor of going into executive session regarding Officer Farrar's pension request.
