There was a special meeting of the Danbury Fire Pension Board on Thursday, March 21, 2013 at 10:00 am in Jim Johnson's office at City Hall.

On the agenda:

1. Pension request of Communications Supervisor Pat Sniffin.
2. A Domestic Relations Order concerning Rey Rodriguez.

The meeting was called to order by Jim Johnson at 10:10 am. In attendance were Mr. Johnson, Mr. Omasta, Mr. Curran by conference call, Mr. Pollard, and Communications Supervisor Pat Sniffin.

First order of business was to accept the DRO concerning Rey Rodriguez. A motion was made to accept the signed DRO by Mr. Pollard and seconded by Mr. Omasta. No discussion. Motion passed by all.

The next order of business was the pension request of Communications Supervisor Pat Sniffin. Mr. Sniffin requested a pension under the Post 67 Pension Plan, Sec. 14-31 (Optional Retirement). He requested his pension to be set to a minimum of 58% (fifty eight percent) of Communication Coordinator salary based on 29 (twenty nine) years of service in accordance with Section 14-31 paragraph 2. His effective day of retirement will be April 2, 2013.

A motion to accept Mr. Sniffin's request was made by Mr. Omasta, seconded by Mr. Pollard, under discussion, Mr. Sniffin was thanked by the Board for his years of dedicated service and for being a definite credit to the Fire Department and the City of Danbury. Motion was passed by all.

A motion to adjourn was made by Mr. Curran, seconded by Mr. Omasta. Motion passed. Adjournment was made.
