

Re: Flow Control Ordinance

In order to have the solid waste flow control ordinances in effect by July 1, 1993 we will have to follow a strict, unforgiving timetable. In order to avoid any mistakes, I will give you a schedule to work with.

1. ~~We will need to cancel the public hearing on the flow control ordinance currently scheduled for March 22, 1993. That public hearing will be held in May, as I will explain below.~~

2. We will need to schedule a special Council meeting for March 22, 1993; I suggest that it precede the public hearing. The purpose of the special meeting will be to consider and act upon the resolution which was presented at the March Council meeting (my copy was erroneously attached to Item #6.). It's the one expressing the Council's intention to designate the Transfer Station as the site for disposal of solid waste.

3. ~~That night, following the special meeting, we must post letters to all Danbury solid waste collectors giving them 60 days' notice of the Council's intention to designate the disposal area for solid waste. A sample copy of such a letter is attached for your use together with a list of the recipients. You should make sure that these letters are ready to go beforehand.~~

4. The sixty-day notice period will expire on May 22, 1993. On that date, the notice of a public hearing on the flow control ordinance (which includes the designation of the disposal area) must be published. The publication must state that a public hearing will be held on the evening of May 27, 1993 to consider the flow control ordinance and should also state that the ordinance will include the designation of a disposal site for all solid waste generated within the City of Danbury. It is imperative that you arrange beforehand for this publication with the News-Times.

5. On May 27, 1993, the Council must hold a public hearing on the ordinance, followed by a special meeting at which the Council will adopt the ordinance.

6. The ordinance must be approved by the Mayor on the 27th or 28th of May and published on May 29, 1993. You must arrange beforehand for this publication with the News-Times so that we will be assured that the ordinance will be effective by July 1, 1993. Remember, ordinances are not effective until 30 days after publication.

If any of this is unclear, or if you have any questions at all, please call me, I'd be more than happy to help. This has to be done just right.
