SECTION 1. The sum of _____ Million _____

(_____) representing the gross appropriation for the City of
Danbury of \$ _____ for the fiscal year of July 1, 1993
and ending June 30, 1994, minus Indirect Revenue of \$ _____ and
minus Estimated Available Fund Balance "Surplus" of \$ _____ plus
uncollectible taxes reserve in the amount of \$ _____ is
hereby levied and assessed on all taxable property in the City of
Danbury as set forth on the annual Grand List as of October 1, 1992.

SECTION 2. Accordingly, the General Fund Tax Rate for the fiscal
year beginning July 1, 1993 and ending June 30, 1994 shall be as
follows:

SECTION 3. The taxes levied and assessed as hereinafter provided

effective date of this resolution, in which case the Tax Collector
shall fix the dates and installments as if said dates had not been
fixed herein as provided by law.

SECTION 4. The Tax Collector shall cause the said taxes above
levied and assessed to be inserted on the tax rolls for the fiscal
year beginning July 1, 1993 and ending June 30, 1994.




