




RE: **Parking Garage & Related improvements**

The City is currently awaiting payment from the State of Connecticut on Requisition #2 in the amount of \$700,000 for the Parking Facilities and Related Improvements in the Downtown Area. Peabody Construction Company, which is the contractor for the parking garage, is due approximately \$571,000 for work completed from May through July 15, 1991. Invoices will also be coming to us from the architects and engineers who are doing work associated with the total \$8,000,000 grant for the downtown area.

It is customary that we seek Common Council approval to borrow funds from the General Fund until payment is received from the State of Connecticut and the Federal Government for various grants. Keep in mind that there are state and federal projects that are appropriations of the General Fund for which the state and federal governments do not reimburse us until funds are expended. This grant is required to be separate from our General Fund. We hereby seek permission from the Common Council to borrow up to a maximum of \$1,000,000 from the General Fund at any time during the course of construction as it relates to the \$8,000,000 grant approved by the State of Connecticut to fund this project. We anticipate that the State will reimburse the City for Requisition #2 in the very near future, and we will be sending a third requisition to the State of Connecticut within the next week or so.


I think it is very important to note that the Peabody Construction Company has cooperated with the City and we have persuaded them to agree to this particular request to the Common Council in lieu of their stopping construction on this
