





The investigation into the water claim referred to the Mayor's Office, for suitable solution, reveals the following information:

The average cost for water use for the 5 periods surrounding the construction of Post Office Street averages \$472.32 per period. The average payment for water use during construction was \$708.52 per period. This yields a difference of \$281.20 per period or \$562.40.


Also, see the attached letter from Attorney Gottschalk detailing his conversation with Mr. Sedney, indicating that a word of mouth contract did exist.

Re: Richard Jowdy - Water Use Claim

Dear Mayor:

I have contacted former Planning Department Director Leonard Sedney concerning the above. I indicated to Mr. Sedney that Mr. Jowdy had submitted a claim against the City for water used by the City in connection with the Post Office Street improvement project. Mr. Sedney acknowledged that he did, in fact, get Mr. Jowdy to agree to allow the City to use water drawn from his tap in return for an agreement by Mr. Sedney, acting on the City's behalf, to pay for the water consumed.

Apparently, when Mr. Sedney explored alternative sources of water the costs were prohibitive and, as a result, Mr. Jowdy's assistance was sought. In order to determine what a fair settlement would be, Mr. Sedney suggested that a comparison be made of Mr. Jowdy's usual water bills (both prior to and after the City's use) and the bills which were generated during months when the City used his water.

From a legal point of view, regardless of Mr. Sedney's authority to commit the City to such a contract, I believe that Mr. Jowdy could recover the reasonable value of the water used by the City. Mr. Sedney would in all likelihood be called upon to testify and would indicate that an agreement was reached and the water used by the City. I recommend that the claim be settled, if possible, based on our best estimate of the City's water consumption.







Re: Improvements at Hatters Community Park

The ad hoc committee appointed to review the appropriation of \$35,904 collected through the rental of Hatters Community Park facilities met on June 13, 1989 at 2:00 P.M. in the Comptroller's Office in City Hall. In attendance were committee members Regan and Connell. Also in attendance were Director of Parks and Recreation Robert Ryerson and Comptroller Dominic Setaro.

Mr. Setaro explained when Hatters Park was brought and set up originally by Resolution of the Common Council, it was decided that any money generated by the facility would be put back into the running and maintenance of the park. Mr. Ryerson stated that the money would be used to fix the roofs of the bowling alley, kitchen and pavilion at the Park.

Mr. Regan made a motion to recommend to the Common Council that \$35,904 collected by the rental of Hatters Community Park facilities be appropriated to the capital line item "Improvements at Hatters Community Park" to be used for the needed roof repairs at the park. Seconded by Mr. Connell. Motion carried unanimously.

Dear Mayor Sauer and Council Members:

As you may already know, the General Assembly adjourned this month before taking action on a bill of concern to the landfill.

The Council had authorized the administration last year to pursue legislation increasing the penalty for dumping illegal garbage at the landfill from \$100.00 to \$5,000.00. The bill died in the House of Representatives.

While this legislation is expected to be resurrected in the next session of the Assembly, we are left with little in the way of "teeth" in our local ordinance to hopefully persuade illegal dumpers from using the facility.

In May, the Council approved an ordinance change which established a four-step penalty procedure, culminating in expulsion from the landfill. Considering our current status, I am requesting a change in Section 16A-34(c) of the Danbury Code of Ordinances (Suspension or revocation of permits).

It is my belief that the suspensions should be dramatically altered to account for the lack of financial disincentive available. Therefore, I would recommend the following changes:

- 16A-34(c)(1) Upon a first offense, any permits issued to the offender shall be suspended for a period of fourteen (14) days.
- 16A-34(c)(2) Upon a second offense, any permits issued to the offender shall be suspended for a period of twenty-eight (28) days.
- 16A-34(c)(3) Upon any subsequent offense, any permit issued to the offender shall be revoked for a period of two (2) years.

Considering the urgency of this matter, I would request that you send this matter straight to public hearing.

I therefore request that the sum of \$40,000.00 be appropriated to the Corporation Counsel's Outside Services Account (029500) to avoid a year-end deficit situation. Please be advised that any monies left over will be returned to the General Fund.


