

It was felt that Ms MacKenzie get in touch with H.A.R.T. to work out some form of transportation for these people so that ^{the} staff employee can do the job that she was hired to do.

It was also brought out that all claims reports that are going to State and Federal Governments for reimbursement are being done manually. The committee recommended Ms. MacKenzie contact the City Date Processing Manager to see if this information can't be put into the computer for faster processing when the information is needed, thereby cutting down on the turnaround time for reimbursements. It was mentioned that turnaround time can take up to 150 dyas and sometimes longer.

Councilman Cassano made a motion, seconded by Councilman Evans that the Welfare Revenue Account #523100 be increased by \$105,000; also increasing the Appropriation Account #02-05-100-026000 by \$105,000. Motion carried unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 6:10 P.M.





As you know we are just completing the repairs to the Pro Shop and Snack Bar as a result of the fire at Richter Park. The building was insured for approximately \$60,000.00, the insurance adjustor's repair estimate was approximately \$30,000.00 which has a 10% deductible clause amounting to approximately \$6,000.00. This left Richter Park with \$24,000.00 to make the repairs to the building.

Due to the insufficient insurance coverage, Richter Park is requesting from the City of Danbury the \$6,000.00 that was deducted from the repair estimate.


