Mr. DaSilva made a motion that the communication be accepted and the names as presented be confirmed as Police Officers of the City of Danbury. Seconded by Mrs. Coladarci.

Mayor Eriquez thanked the Common Council for its cooperation and explained the reason for the short notice and the urgency of this meeting.

Mr. Levy asked if three of these positions are funded by the Cops Ahead Program. Mayor Eriquez replied that there are 12 positions available. Three are funded by the Cops Ahead Program and the remaining eight are funded in the City budget. Hopefully within the next few months the 12th position will be filled.

Mr. Nolan complimented the Mayor for pushing this ahead and securing the slots at the Police Academy. We have finally reached the level we want to be at.

Motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Eriquez stated that these candidates took the Civil Service Exam in June, 1993. This list will expire in November, 1995 and he thanked the Civil Service Commission and Nicholas Nero, the Civil Service Examiner for being so cooperative in commencing a new list.
