Mr. DaSilva made a motion that the call and return of service be accepted. Seconded by Mr. Boynton. Motion carried unanimously.

PUBLIC SPEAKING - There were no members of the public wishing to address the Common Council.

1 - COMMUNICATION - Request for approval of water extension to the Metro North Commuter Railroad Station. It was explained that due to a miscommunication between the railroad and its consulting engineering firm, Common Council approval was not secured. Mr. Boynton made a motion to grant the water extension to the Metro North Commuter Railroad Station, subject to the regular eight steps. Seconded by Mr. Gallagher.


