SUBJECT: Minutes of the Common Council Meeting held on Dec. 3, 1985.

The meeting was called to order at 8:00 O'Clock P.M. by the Honorable Mayor James E. Dyer who led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

The Prayer was offered by Councilman John Esposito.

A moment of silence was observed due to the death of Dan Garamella who was the Director of Public Works and Frank Repole who served as a former Councilman.

Resolved by the Common Council of the City of Danbury:

Whereas, the State of Connecticut Department of Health Services has made funds available to municipalities in accordance with Section 19a-202 of the Connecticut General Statutes; and

Whereas, the City of Danbury, Inc. through the Danbury Health and Housing Department has formulated a program to promote optimal environmental quality in the City of Danbury; and

Whereas, a continuation grant award request of \$18,942 with no local match requirement will be processed by the Danbury Health Department;

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved That the actions of the Danbury Health and Housing Department in applying for the said grant be and hereby are ratified and that any and all further actions by the Danbury Health & Housing Department required to accomplish said program be and hereby are authorized;

Be it further resolved that to accomplish said program, James E. Dyer, Mayor of the City of Danbury, Inc. is authorized to make, execute, and approve on behalf of this corporation any and all contracts or amendments thereof with the State of Connecticut of Health Services.

The Commission on Aging has a significant sum of money in the City Revenue Fund, among which was \$1500 gift from a local corporation to be used for office and activity supplies at "Interweave" the Danbury Adult Day Care Center. Councilman Esposito placed the name of Councilman Bernard Gallo in nomination for election to the Police Pension Board. Seconded by Councilman Torian.

Councilman DaSilva placed the name of Councilman Louis Charles in nomination for election to the Police Pension Board. Seconded by Councilman Enriquez.

By a roll call vote of 13 to 7, Councilman Gallo was elected to the Police Pension Board.

Council Members Johnson, Sollose, Philip, Torcaso, Zotos, Hadley, Cassano, McManus, Gallo, Esposito, Boynton, Butera and Torian voted for Councilman Gallo (13 votes)

Council Members - Godfrey, Flanagan, Skoff, Charles, DaSilva, Enriquez, and Smith voted for Councilman Charles. (7 votes) 1 member was absent.

Councilman Charles asked that Councilman Gallo's election be unanimous. Request was granted.

016 - Election to the Fire Pension Board.

Councilman Flanagan placed the name of Councilman Joseph DaSilva in nomination for election to the Fire Pension Board. Seconded by Councilman Enriquez.

Councilman Zotos placed the name of Councilman Louis Charles in nomination for election to the Fire Pension Board. Seconded by Councilman Hadley.

By a roll call vote of 15 to 5, Councilman DaSilva was elected to the Fire Pension Board.

Council Members Johnson, Philip, Torcaso, Godfrey, Flanagan, Skoff, Cassano, Esposito, Charles, Boynton, Butera, DaSilva, Enriquez, Smith and Torian voted for DaSilva (15 votes)

Council Members - Sollose, Zotos, Hadley, McManus, Gallo, voted for Councilman Charles (5 votes).

017 - COMMUNICATION - Request from Common Council President for an ad hoc committee to be formed for the purpose of appointing a Charter Revision Commission. This would be in accordance with the applicable State Statutes.

There are several areas of the Charter which would seem to be in need of attention. These would include purchasing requirements, the length of the municipal ballot and Common Council procedures dealing with such items as ad hoc committees.

Councilwoman McManus requested referral to committee. Mayor Dyer so ordered and appointed the following ad hoc committee: Gallo, McManus, Esposito.

018 - COMMUNICATION & CERTIFICATION - Request from John P. Edwards, Acting Director of Finance for the Common Council to supplement the Employee Service Benefit Account 02-09-122-071003. This account required \$14,321.29 to fund the account for the balance of the fiscal year. The need for funds in this account was reduced by transferring \$25,000.00 from the Employee Merit Increase Account 02-09-122-071004, which is no longer needed.

022 - REPORT - Fallen Rocks on Golden Hill Road.

Councilman DaSilva submitted a report stating that the Public Works committee studied a request to investigate a problem of fallen rocks on Golden Hill Road. In the building of a new home and the accompanying excavation and landscaping of the lot, a wall of assorted size rocks was built on a boundary of the property. Numerous rocks have fallen from this wall onto adjoining property.

The committee checked with the Zoning Board of Appeals decision dealing with the new building and the Assistant Corporation Counsel, concerning City responsibility. It is the decision of all concerned that, although this rock wall has caused a number of problems, it is a civil matter which goes beyond the responsibility of the Common Council. The committee recommends no action be taken on this petition at this time.

The Report and committee recommendations were accepted by the Common Council on the Consent Calendar.

023 - REPORT - Firewood Sale.

Common Council President C. McManus submitted a report stating that the Common Council held its annual firewood sale at the landfill on Nov. 17th and again on December 1, 1985. A total of \$1,780 was raised and the Council wishes to thank Byron Johnson and the Forestry Department both, for cutting the wood and helping the Council members to load it into residents cars.

A recommendation was made by Council Members Torcaso, Butera and Johnson, that \$593.33 each be given to the Marine Corps, the Salvation Army and residents of Ives Manor, to purchase Christmas gifts for needy Danbury residents.

Councilman Godfrey questioned the donation to the Salvation Army, upon which a motion was then made by Councilwoman McManus, seconded by Councilman Boynton to change the donation from the Salvation Army to the Daniel Garamella Scholarship fund. Motion carried unanimously.

024 - COMMUNICATION - Lakecrest Drive.

Request from Leonard G. Sedney, Planning Director for the Common Council to authorize \$57,000 to complete work on the above Lakecrest Drive, and then the City will take the necessary steps to seek reimbursement. The \$57,000 is based upon a June estimate of the City Engineer's office.

Councilwoman Butera requested referral to the Public Works Committee & Planning Mayor Dyer so ordered the referral and appointed the following ad hoc committee: Cassano, Butera and Charles.

025 - COMMUNICATION & RESOLUTION - Securing Easements in connection with the Post Office Street Project.

RESOLUTION - Resolved by the Common Council of the City of Danbury:

Whereas, the Common Council wishes to acquire interests in real property sufficient to allow the placement of utilities underground and access for maintenance purposes to these utilities in connection with street and sidewalk improvements to Post Office Street; and

Whereas, said proposal will involve public use of private property, specifically property interests identified on a map as Exhibit A; attached hereto;

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved By The Common Council That the Corporation Counsel be and hereby is authorized to acquire private property interests either by negotiations or by eminent domain through the institution of suit against the current property owners and their respective encumbrances, if any.

The Resolution was adopted by the Common Council on the Consent Calendar.

026 - REPORT - Greater Danbury Vietnam Veterans Memorial, Inc.

Councilman Godfrey submitted a progress report in reference to the above subject matter, stating that the committee is a newly organized steering group which purpose is to provide the region with an appropriate remembrance of those men and women who served in the Vietnam War. The committee members are: Richard Cacace of New Fairfield - John Hill, Jr. of Danbury - Leo F. Moore of Danbury - James Purcell, Jr. of Danbury - (Treasurer) Patrick Waldron of Danbury (Danbury's Veterans Advisor) Robert D. Godfrey of Danbury (Secretary).

The committee has split its work into two tasks: fund raising and the monument. The Committee is appreciative of the commitment of Mayor Dyer of a substantial sum of money from next year's City budget. A "Sponsors Committee" is being formed to promote the major fund raising drive, to begin early in 1986. With regard to the monument, Leo Moore has begun efforts to pick a suitable site, and John Hill has contacted local artist Jack Barrows and sculptor Al Matthews to assist in the creation of a statue that will emphasize the American combatant's humanity.

The design has been completed for the signal system, and \$100,000.00 is required to fund the project. Approximately \$40,000 is left from the original land acquisition and road construction appropriation, meaning that a \$60,000 approval from the Contingency fund will fund the signal installation.

Mayor Dyer is recommending immediate approval and the waiver of bids to expedite the signal installation, as one intersection has become a very busy one, and safety requires prompt attention.

CERTIFICATION #17 was submitted by Mr. John P. Edwards, Acting Director of Finance certifying \$60,000 as being available in the Contingency Fund for transfer to a new Capital Projects Account for intersection improvements at Deer Hill Avenue and Wooster Street.

Councilwoman Butera requested referral to committee and Planning Commission. Mayor Dyer so ordered and appointed the following ad hoc committee: Flanagan, Zotos, Eriquez.

030 - COMMUNICATION - Household Hazardous Waste Days..

Communication from Mayor Dyer stating that in the interest of environmental protection, we should schedule household hazardous waste days. It will cost an estimated \$40,000 to dispose of the hazardous waste collected. If we act prior to July 1, 1986 we can obtain up to 50% reimbursement from the State of Connecticut. Bill Quinn has been coordinating our participation in such a waste collection day.
