Mr. DaSilva made a motion to accept the call and the return of service. Seconded by Mrs. Bourne. Motion carried unanimously.

1. COMMUNICATION - Letter from Republican Town Committee Chairman Gary Kurpiewski recommending the name of Roger M. Bundy to fill the vacant at-large Common Council seat. Mr. Nimmons placed the name of Roger M. Bundy in nomination. Seconded by Mr. Moran. Mrs. Bourne made a motion to close the nominations. Seconded by Mr. Connell. Motion carried unanimously. Motion made and seconded to nominate Roger M. Bundy to fill the vacant at-large Common Council seat passed unanimously.

2. COMMUNICATION - Letter from Mayor Joseph H. Sauer appointing Christine Appel to the Environmental Impact Commission for a term to expire 12-1-90. Mr. Godfrey made a motion to accept the communication and confirm the appointment. Seconded by Mr. Flanagan. Motion carried unanimously.


Mayor Sauer administered the oath of office to Mr. Bundy.

There were no members of the public wishing to address the Common Council.


Mayor Sauer offered a few words to the Common Council on the vernal equinox and wished everyone a happy holiday.
