Attached, please find a resolution authorizing the City of Danbury to enter into necessary contracts and agreements with the U.S. Department of Homeland Security for the purpose of participating in a facility security assessment program. This is a voluntary program that is being offered by the Department of Homeland Security through coordination with the CT Department of Public Health Drinking Water Section.

Other than our time, there is no cost to participate in this program. This is an opportunity to have the U.S. Department of Homeland Security inspect our facilities and offer recommendations for improvements to our existing security measures. In addition to receiving independent security improvement recommendations we are hopeful that participation in this program may provide us with an opportunity to receive Homeland Security Funding for Danbury Water Facility security projects.

All information gathered by the Federal Government through our voluntary participation in this program is protected from Freedom of Information Act disclosure, from State and local disclosure laws, from use in civil litigation, and cannot be used as the basis of regulatory action. All information submitted is protected from disclosure as provided by the provisions of the Critical Infrastructure Information Act of 2002.
