Also in attendance were; Deputy Corporation Counsel Les Pinter; Director of Finance, David St. Hilaire ; Chief of Staff Wayne Sheppard and members of the Public.

Mr. Sheppard said the Neighborhood Assistance Act is where non-profits can apply for up to a 60% tax credit from the State. Fourteen groups have applied for approval for the tax credit.

Mr. Rotello asked if there was any affect on Danbury property taxes. Mr. Sheppard said no.

Mr. Saadi asked if the Board of Education could apply. Mr. Pinter said probably not as they are not classified as a non-profit.

Mr. Saadi moved to recommend adoption of the Neighborhood Assistance Act as presented. Seconded by Mr. Visconti. The motion passed unanimously.
