Pension Contributions: Code of Ordinance—Section 14-8


Mr. Knapp moved to recommend adoption of amendments to Code of Ordinance Section 14-8, as clarified by the addition of the words, "...as defined for pension purposes." After the word salary on line 6 addressing contributions to the City's pension plan. The motion was seconded by Mr. Nagarsheth. A discussion ensued regarding those effected, the percentage of employee contributions, and the mechanism for collecting the employee contribution. D. St. Hilaire clarified these points for the Committee. **Vote, all in favor, motion unanimously approved.**

ORDINANCE

CITY OF DANBURY, STATE OF CONNECTICUT

CITY COUNCIL

_____ A.D. 2010

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Danbury:

THAT Chapter 1, Section 14-8 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Danbury is hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 14-8. Contributions by employee and employer.

Contributions necessary to provide the benefits under this plan shall be made by the employer, and no employee as defined in Section 14-2 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Danbury, except those non-union employees hired subsequent to January 1, 2011, shall be required to make any contributions. Those non-union employees hired subsequent to January 1, 2011 shall contribute five percent (5%) of their base annual salary as defined for pension purposes. Contributions shall be made to the trustee from time to time in amounts sufficient to assure the successful operation of the plan on a sound actuarial basis as determined by periodic actuarial computations.

The employer shall pay the expenses of administering the plan, including any compensation of the trustee and the compensation of the actuaries.

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Sec. 14-8. Contributions by employee and employer.

Contributions necessary to provide the benefits under this plan shall be made by the employer and no employee AS DEFINED IN SECTION 14-2 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF DANBURY, EXCEPT THOSE NON-UNION EMPLOYEES HIRED SUBSEQUENT TO JANUARY 1, 2011, shall BE REQUIRED TO make any contributions. THOSE NON-UNION EMPLOYEES HIRED SUBSEQUENT TO JANUARY 1, 2011 SHALL CONTRIBUTE FIVE PERCENT (5%) OF THEIR BASE ANNUAL SALARY AS DEFINED FOR PENSION PURPOSES. Contributions shall be made to the trustee from time to time in amounts sufficient to assure the successful operation of the plan on a sound actuarial basis as determined by periodic actuarial computations.

The employer shall pay the expenses of administering the plan, including any compensation of the trustee and the compensation of the actuaries.

Note: New language is indicated by CAPITALIZATION COMBINED WITH UNDERLINING except that capitalization is not utilized for the letters in parentheses which indicate subsections.

Deleted language is indicated by strikeouts.
