RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DANBURY

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency ("FEMA") Region 1 has completed its review of Danbury's Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan, and can conditionally authorize its adoption; and

WHEREAS, such Plan encourages a community to deal with a variety of natural disasters, such as hurricanes and floods, with the primary goal of the Plan is to reduce the loss of life, property, infrastructure and natural, cultural and economic resources in the community resulting from those disasters; and

WHEREAS, the adoption of an approved plan within one year of FEMA's conditional approval provides for eligibility for a Mitigation grant offered by FEMA.
