RE: **Community Development Block Grant Program – Program Year 38**

Attached is a resolution which will allow the City of Danbury to approve and submit the City's Annual Action Plan for Program Year 38 projects, and a Section 108 Loan Guarantee application for infrastructure improvements, to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for the Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG).

Available funding for the time period August 1, 2012 through July 31, 2013 (Program Year 38) totals \$534,449. No local cash match is required. A Section 108 Loan Guarantee application will be submitted for up to \$1.8 million. The City will provide a pledge of a portion of future CDBG grants for the Section 108 loan program. A listing of the Policy Committee's recommendations is attached.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT Mark D. Boughton, Mayor of the City of Danbury, is hereby authorized to approve and submit the City's Annual Action Plan for Program Year 38 projects and a Section 108 Loan Guarantee Application for up to \$1.8 million for infrastructure improvements in the Foster Street area including adjacent LMI eligible areas as determined by the Mayor in accordance with 24 CFR 570.208 (a) and 24 CFR 570.700 and provide a pledge of future CDBG grants pursuant to 24 CFR 570.705 (b) (2) and such additional security as the Mayor may determine as allowed by HUD, and make an application on behalf of the City of Danbury to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development for funds for the Community Development Annual Action Plan commencing August 1, 2012 through July 31, 2013 for the Thirty-Eight Year in accordance with all pertinent laws and regulations and the Statement of Community Development Objectives and Projected Use of Funds proposed by the Mayor's Community Development Program Policy Committee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT Mark D. Boughton, Mayor of the City of Danbury, is hereby authorized to execute all contracts and take necessary actions to effectuate the purposes of said grant applications.
