Dear Mayor and Council Members:

In order to apply for State DPH Drinking Water State Revolving Funds (DWSRF) to help subsidize the cost of an emergency generator for the Hawthorne Terrace Water System a resolution must be adopted by the applicant authorizing a specific person to file the application and execute the funding agreement. If the application is approved, the Small System Emergency Power Generator Program will fund 45% of the cost of the generator as a grant with the remaining 55% of the cost being funded as a 20 year DWSRF loan.
