
It is with great pride and honor that I hereby submit for your confirmation the promotional appointment of Lieutenant William Lounsbury to the position of Fire Captain.

I hereby submit for your confirmation the appointment and promotion of the following Fire Fighters to the position of Fire Lieutenant:


