Attached for your consideration is a request to update the previous resolution of \$773,788.90 to \$791,757.00. This request is being made as the Lighting Panel that is located in the Air Traffic Control Tower failed while this project was under way to rehabilitate the Hazard and Rotating Beacons. We had originally placed this equipment in the original request to the FAA, it went out to bid but the FAA did not have enough monies to fund all of the items in the bid so it was placed aside. The FAA found the additional monies after the panel failed and our share is \$454.00 (coming out of current Airport Budget 2070-5500.2440), the FAA share is \$16,167.00 and the State of Ct is \$1,348.00.

RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DANBURY

WHEREAS, State and federal grant funds are made available to the City of Danbury Municipal Airport ("DXR") through application in accordance with State and Federal guidelines; and

WHEREAS, at the present time the Airport is in need of certain projects in order to facilitate proper DXR operations, including the rehabilitation of hazard beacons and a rotating beacon; the replacement of a control panel in ATC; the installation of signs on Taxiway R; and markings for Taxiway R; and

WHEREAS, the City of Danbury desires to secure funding for these purposes through accessing available grant funds; and

WHEREAS, the Federal share would be \$712,576.00, State share \$59,382.00 and local match is \$19,799.00, for a total of \$791,757.00; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the City of Danbury that it secure said funds to accomplish these purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT Mayor Mark D. Boughton or his designee, Paul D. Estefan, Airport Administrator, be and hereby is authorized to apply for and receive grant funding from the Federal Aviation Administration and the State of Connecticut toward the costs of the referenced improvements, expend local share as applicable and to execute such documents as may be required to accomplish the purposes thereof.
