This family restaurant is known for its famous Texas Hot Weiner. The establishment has grown a large fan club throughout the years, but it may be the hot dogs that bring new crowds. Long-time Danbury residents insist that throughout their travels, they've never come across anything like it.

JK's owners have seen the same loyal patrons come to eat generation after generation. They like to think of the restaurant as a place to call home, where everyone is considered family.
