

**Directions to Rogers Park Middle School: From the West:** Travel I-84 East to Exit 5. Proceed past the stop sign and continue to the traffic light. Turn right onto Main Street and follow Directions from Main St. **From the East:** Travel I-84 West to Exit 5. Turn right at the traffic light at the end of the exit and follow Directions from Main St. **Directions from Main St:** Follow Main Street through the downtown area. At the end of Main Street cross over into the park onto Memorial Drive (a large war statue will be on your left). Follow Memorial Drive past the athletic field on your right. Rogers Park will be on the right. Parking is available for visitors in the front of the building and in the side parking lot.
