2008 Neighborhood Assistance Act


Councilman Calandrino moved to recommend the adoption of the Resolution to approve the organization and participation the Neighborhood Assistance Act.

RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Danbury:

WHEREAS, the Connecticut Neighborhood Assistance Act Program is available for area non profits to submit applications for funding; and

WHEREAS, the Act provides tax credits for businesses which contribute to community programs having received both municipal and state approval; and

WHEREAS, certain local and area organizations are seeking to apply through Danbury for such tax credits; and

WHEREAS, no local matching funds are required; and

WHEREAS, said organizations and their requests are as set forth on the attached schedule.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the City of Danbury through its Common Council, hereby approves, subject to a public hearing as required by law, those organizations set forth in the schedule, for participation in the Neighborhood Assistance Program, and authorize Mark D.
