Dear Mr. Mayor Boughton,

I want to bring to your attention a very serious and possibly life-threatening situation that myself and all my neighbors are experiencing.

The City of Danbury has two Cornell Roads one is city owned and the other is a private road. My residence is located on the city owned road near Danbury Airport, the other is a private road located near Candlewood Lake. The two Cornell Roads are at opposite ends of the city.

Our problem is, many of the residences share the same street numbers a multiple number of times. On several occasions I have had had professional drivers from, Ups, FedX and the U.S Mail deliver mail and or packages to my home that should have gone to the other 5 Cornell Road. On at least one occasion two Police cars came onto my Cornell Road and were looking for an address on the other Cornell Road. In an emergency situation when the Police or other emergency personnel are dispatched to the right address but to the wrong end of the city, lives could be lost, and or property damaged. Emergency personnel still have to check the residence of the wrong home to make sure that this home is not the emergency. Then race across the city or call for other emergency personnel who cover that part of the city to respond.

I propose that the numbers on the east Cornell Road start at 200; this way fire and police will know what side of town to go to. We need to have this situation addressed immediately before something very tragic happens. I look forward to your comments and recommendations, you can call me at {203} 792-5131.
