

**WHEREAS**, the Federal Aviation Administration, pursuant to federal stimulus legislation recently enacted pursuant to the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, has awarded three hundred and fifty thousand dollars (\$350,000.00) in funds to the City of Danbury Municipal Airport; and

**WHEREAS** said funds will be allocated to conduct a Miscellaneous Study, Analyze Runway 26 Approaches/Obstructions for the Danbury Municipal Airport; and

**WHEREAS**, there is no required local or state match for the purposes of this program.
