The City of Danbury has another opportunity to continue its successful Summer Youth Employment program for six weeks, beginning July 6, 2009.

The Northwest Regional Workforce Investment Board is overseeing an American Recovery and Reinvestment Act program to hire approximately 85 youngsters to participate in internships and clean teams. The participants will be placed in various city departments, non-profit agencies as well as private businesses.

There will also be seven adult and student supervisors to monitor the participants.


Students participating must meet established income criteria. They will earn \$8.00 per hour for 20 hours of work per week. Supervisors will receive \$16 per hour. The overall project will be valued at \$109,451.00

As part of this program, students will participate in life skills training sessions provided by the Sylvan Learning Center.

The Office of the Mayor will monitor the overall program.

# RESOLUTION

**RESOLVED** by the Common Council of the City of Danbury:



**WHEREAS**, the Northwest Regional Workforce Investment Board will oversee an American Recovery and Reinvestment Act program allowing the creation of a Summer Youth Employment Program in Danbury; and

**WHEREAS**, this funding will allow the city to employ up to 85 low income youths to participate in internships and clean teams throughout the community; and

**WHEREAS**, the program will be monitored by City departments, including the Office of the Mayor.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT** Mayor Mark D. Boughton be and hereby is authorized to make application for and receive a grant from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act and distributed through the Northwest Connecticut Workforce Investment Board in an amount approximated to be \$109,451.00 for the purposes of establishing a Summer Youth Employment Program, and to take all necessary actions in order to accomplish the purposes thereof.
