RE: **Community Development Block Grant Program – Program Year 35**

Attached is a resolution which will allow the City of Danbury to apply for and accept funding from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for the Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG).

Available funding for the time period August 1, 2009 through July 31, 2010 (Program Year 35) totals \$627,187. CDBG stimulus funding has been made available for the time period August 1, 2008 through July 31, 2009 (Program Year 34) totaling \$168,222. No local cash match is required. A listing of the Policy Committee's recommendations is attached.

The Common Council is respectfully requested to consider this resolution at its next meeting.



WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the City of Danbury to apply for a grant under such Act; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT Mark D. Boughton, Mayor of the City of Danbury, is hereby authorized to approve and submit the City's Annual Action Plan for Program Year 35 and make application on behalf of the City of Danbury to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development for grant funds for the Community Development Program Year commencing August 1, 2009 through July 31, 2010 for the Thirty-Fifth Year Funding in accordance with all pertinent laws and regulations and the Statement of Community Development Objectives and Projected Use of Funds proposed by the Mayor's Community Development Program Policy Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT Mark D. Boughton, Mayor of the City of Danbury, is hereby authorized to approve and submit an amendment to the City's Annual Action Plan for Program Year 34 for grant funds for the Community Development Program Year commencing August 1, 2008 through July 31, 2009 for the Thirty-Fourth Year Funding in accordance with all pertinent laws and regulations and the Statement of Community Development Objectives and Projected Use of Funds proposed by the Mayor's Community Development Program Policy Committee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT Mark D. Boughton, Mayor of the City of Danbury, is hereby authorized to execute all contracts and take all necessary actions to effectuate the purposes of this grant application.
