

The following are justifications for the items that the Danbury Police is requesting to purchase under the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant. These items will assist the Danbury Police Department in several areas including investigative, community service, and tactical

One (1) Ford Taurus AWD unmarked police vehicle

This grant project item is for one Ford Taurus AWD unmarked police cruiser. When purchased, this vehicle will be used by the Danbury Police Department detective bureau. This vehicle will be used for investigative purposes by this unit. This vehicle is being purchased as a replacement for two vehicles that had been cut from the City of Danbury police budget due to reduced revenue concerns.
