Request for Time Extension for Water Main Approval  
228 Middle River Road – George L. Trudell II

As per Sec. 21-21 of the Code of Ordinances, at the October 6, 2009 Common Council meeting, the September 28, 2009 request by George L. Trudell II of KASL, LLC for approval of a time extension for the water main extension to serve the above noted property (Tax Assessor's Lot No. C07014) was referred to our office for a report (reference item 10 of the meeting minutes).

The Common Council previously approved the proposed water main extension for this site at its regular August 1, 2006 meeting. The Engineering Division supports the requested time extension. If the time extension is approved, we will work out the details of the extension with the petitioner's engineer. As noted in the Common Council's 2006 approval, the petitioner needs to extend the water main past the half-way mark of his property line and must follow the standard 8 steps/conditions (copy enclosed).
