Dear Members of the Danbury Common Council:

The members of the Aqua Vista Association, a Danbury community on Candlewood Lake, request that the City of Danbury assume the operation of the existing community water system. There are sixty-three residences serviced by four wells plus an additional reserve well on community property.

At the present time, the wells are in good working order and have been maintained properly according to the State of Connecticut water regulations. The monitoring of the systems has been done on a volunteer basis. Because of the stringent requirements of the state, the amount of time it takes for our resident volunteer to monitor the system and the absolute necessity for an uninterrupted future water supply, we ask the City of Danbury for its assistance.

Members of the Aqua Vista Association have spoken with Superintendent Mario Ricozzi regarding this matter. We are attaching the required petition for this request. If you need any additional information on our situation, please contact us.

We respectfully submit this petition, and as taxpayers of the City of Danbury look forward to affirmative consideration by the Common Council.
