Common Council Members,

The Boehringer-Ingelheim Pharmaceuticals, Inc. campus resides within the City of Danbury and the Town of Ridgefield sharing property between both communities. We are planning to develop a portion of the Ridgefield side of the campus to construct a new facility that will be used as a Child Care Center. The Child Care Center will be 18,800 square feet and will accommodate a maximum of 181 children and 44 employees.

During the process of designing the new facility and working with the City of Danbury Engineer, it has been determined that the 6-inch water main located within the Saw Mill/Old Ridgebury Roadways could be used to supply potable water to the Child Care Center. We are requesting support of the Common Council to allow Boehringer Ingelheim to make connection to the water main and provide service to our new facility. The water main is located in Ridgefield, however, it is owned by the City of Danbury. Your support is an essential part for this project.

The facility load will be 13 sinks, 28 lavatories, 19 toilets and 1 cloth washer. Our estimated water requirement is 3,620 gallons per day based upon the fixtures mentioned above and the kitchen load requirements.
