Attached please find the statistical analysis for repairs and maintenance work that the Public Buildings Mechanics engaged in during the month of July. In the month of July we received 160 new work requests and completed 144 work requests. In reviewing this report, you will find the repair time that was expended in major work categories, (current month versus previous month). Also listed is the total number of work order hours completed, (current month versus the previous month).

Our department was heavily engaged in electrical repairs of the City's buildings and schools with a total of 319.50 man-hours dedicated to this service. The next largest area of concentration was in mechanical repairs, utilizing 229.50 man-hours of labor. Plumbing repairs were the third highest category with 178.00 man-hours.


