

Over the years our office has completed many jobs for the City of Danbury including Downtown Façade Study, Downtown Façade Improvement Study, The Old Library Renovation & Elevator Addition, The Bear Mountain Ranger Residence and Barn, Hatter's Yard Condos, The Hearthstone Castle Study, Downtown Street Improvement Preliminaries, School Based Health Center, The Terrywile Barn & Lavatories and The Danbury Senior Center.

In closing the office we have been very fortunate in that Western Connecticut State University has decided to archive all our work at the University Library. We have one piece we had intended to put in the archives but upon further consideration we thought we would prefer to donate it to the City if they were willing to hang it somewhere where the public could see and enjoy it. The piece we are referring, commissioned by then Mayor Dyer, contains ink drawings of both sides of Main Street from White Street to West Street, at 1/8" scale exactly as it appeared in 1981. The drawings were made from photographs taken by Gilles Rosseau Studio, in scale with a vertical corrective lens. The piece is professionally framed in a black wood frame and glass measuring 6' long and 1'-2" high.

If the City is interested in taking it, we would be greatly honored to make this donation.
