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
RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Danbury:

Re: Energy Supplement for Residential Facilities

As you are aware, PA 05-02 of the October Special Session appropriated \$2,000,000 to OPM "to provide supplemental compensation for heating costs for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2006, to residential facilities that are supported by state funds, including, but not limited to, nursing homes ..." . In consideration of an expeditious disbursement of funds, it was determined the money would be distributed on a per bed stipend for beds in residential facilities that are used by state supported residents.

Based on information submitted by all the impacted state agencies, the calculated per bed/ resident stipend was determined to be \$61.67. To calculate the individual contractors reimbursement for the Emergency Homeless Shelters, the department obtained information from the submitted quarterly demographic reports.

On February 2, 2006, the allotment distributing the \$2,000,000 to the impacted state agencies was signed by Governor Rell. With the allotment processed, we finalized our individual facility calculations.

While the enclosed check may not cover the entire increase in your winter heating bills, it is an effort to provide some assistance during these winter months. Thank you for your continued dedication to the provision of quality services to our needy Connecticut clients.
