Sewer Request- 102 Federal Road

Chairman Robert Riley called the meeting to order at 7:01 P.M. Committee member Councilman Thomas Saadi was present. Councilman Shay Nagarsheth was out of town on business. Also in attendance were Antonio Iadarola P.E., Director of Public Works, James Johnson and Michael Calandrino ex officio and members of the public.

Mr. Riley read the charge of the Committee, which was to review the request for sanitary sewer at 102 Federal Road. He stated that a positive recommendation was received from the Planning Commission.

Mr. Iadarola gave an overview of the details of the request, which was for sewer extension at the intersection of International Drive and Federal Road. It would run approximately 1800 linear feet and was within the state road. The Department of Transportation would need to issue a permit to the petitioner.

Discussion followed regarding watershed concerns, clarification of the DOT permit, responsibility of payment and the on-call consultant.

Mr. Saadi and Mr. Iadarola expressed their concerns regarding the absence of the petitioner or their representative. Mr. Riley responded that he had no knowledge of the reason for their nonattendance.

Mr. Saadi moved to approve the sewer petition as presented, subject to the standard eight steps, as well as any other conditions that the Department of Public Works and the State of Connecticut may impose. Second by Mr. Riley. There was no further discussion. Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Saadi moved to adjourn at 7:08 P.M. Second by Mr. Riley. Motion passed unanimously.
