
WHEREAS, A Personal Service Agreement authorizing funding for the cost of such a facility will be required to be executed by the parties; and




Ottilie W. Lundgren Memorial Mobile Field Hospital




Facility

- Multi-purpose, easily deployable




100 Bed Configuration




Facility
