

**AD HOC REPORT
Request for Water at 109 Park Avenue**

Chairman Robert Riley called the meeting to order at 7:26 P.M. p.m. In attendance were committee members Councilman Thomas Saadi, Councilwoman Louise McMahon; Laszlo Pinter, Deputy Corporation Counsel; Farid Khouri, P.E., City Engineer; Antonio Iadarola, P.E. Director of Public Works, Dean Martin of Drumman Engineers, Atty. David Grogins representing the petitioner and Nick Discala and Brian Terzian of A. M. Santella, Inc.

Mr. Riley read the charge of the committee, which is to consider request for water extension at 109 Park Ave.

Mr. Iadarola stated that this is a very simple request for an extension to the existing water line at 109 Park Ave.

Mr. Grogins stated a hydrant would be installed as stipulated by the City and that it was otherwise a straightforward request.

Mr. Saadi inquired as to the requirement of any variances or special exceptions and was there any reason to require a larger pipe. There were none.

Mr. Rotello asked if there would be enough water pressure. Mr. Iadarola stated that a flow test was done to ensure there is adequate pressure.

Mrs. McMahon advised that a positive response was received from the Planning Commission.

Mrs. McMahon moved to grant the request for water extension to the existing line and 109 Park Avenue. Seconded by Mr. Saadi. Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Saadi moved to adjourn at 7:31 P.M. Seconded by Mrs. McMahon. Motion passed unanimously.
