

Personal Property Tax accounts remain uncollected due to various reasons (i.e. no longer in business, bankruptcy filed). We also work in conjunction with the Health Department,

as permits will not be issued to businesses with outstanding Personal Property Tax due. Motor Vehicle Tax accounts are reported to the Department of Motor Vehicles and registrations will not be renewed until these accounts are brought current. The City has also engaged an outside agency to help in recovering outstanding Motor Vehicle Taxes.
