### MINUTES ANNUAL MEETING DECEMBER 7, 2009

The meeting was called to order at 6:02 p.m. by Chairman Arthur J. Mannion, Jr. Present were members Arthur J. Mannion, Jr., William Boehm, Joseph Pepin and Hillel Goldman. Assistant Corporation Counsel Sharon Wicks Dornfeld was also present.

Mr. Mannion noted the vacancy on the Board remaining due to the death of Margaret Koeschel. He stated that the only noticed business was the preparation of the Annual Report to the City Council.

The Board reviewed the draft of the Report. Mr. Goldman moved the approval of the draft and the preparation of the final report. Mr. Boehm seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Mannion noted that there has been a proposal introduced to the Legislature in each of the past two years to establish a State Ethics law which would apply to all municipalities. Although it has not yet been reported out of committee, in his opinion the very detailed bill, if enacted, would require a major change to the City's ethics rules.

There being no further business, Mr. Pepin moved to adjourn, seconded by Mr. Goldman. The motion carried unanimously.

Chairman Mannion adjourned the meeting at 6:14 p.m.
