There was a monthly meeting of the Danbury Fire Pension Board held on August 15 2013 at 4:10pm in the office of the Fire Marshal at City Hall. In attendance were Mr. Slagle, Mr. Pollard, Mayor Boughton, and by teleconference, Mr. Omasta.

On the agenda:

1. Pension fund recommendations of Greystone Consultants.
2. The pension request of Fire Marshal Jim Johnson.

Mr. Johnson requested a pension under Post 1967, Sec. 14-33 "Retirement for disabilities not connected with duties". Two doctor's reports were received on Mr. Johnson and both agreed he could not perform his duties and the disability was not job incurred. A motion to pension Mr. Johnson was made by Mr. Pollard and seconded by Mr. Boughton. There was no discussion and the motion passed. Mr. Johnson's last day will be the end of the pay period, 7:00 am August 18, 2013. He was thanked for his 39 years of dedicated service to the City of Danbury.

(Mr. Johnson pension will be for 39 years (39 x 2% per year=78%) plus the 5% non service connected disability, which equals eighty-three percent (83%) of top step Fire Marshal salary.)
