Councilman Cavo read the call of the meeting to consider acceptance of a Monument from the October agenda.

Councilman Cavo asked Public Works Director Iadarola to give a brief update on the item.

Mr. Iadarola stated the monument met all the guidelines of the zoning and building requirements for the placement of this monument. As of this date, no other organization has requested to place a monument on City property. Constructed under our supervision and standards so as not to be obtrusive

Councilman Esposito asked if guidelines exist to have approval before monuments are built so we may avoid this situation in the future. Mr. Iadarola stated, he would give guidelines to any organization wishing to place a monument.

Further discussion followed from ex-officio members Calandrino, Chianese and Visconti regarding restrictions and subject matter and whether guidelines have been reviewed by Corporation Counsel.
