Quarterly Meeting Minutes

A request for pension was received from Captain Eric Handau under section 14-31 (Option retirement). Motion made by Tomchik and seconded by Levy to accept his request for pension.

Under discussion - Captain Handau would like his last day of work to be on August 1st 2020. Captain Handau will have completed 27 years of service to the City of Danbury Fire Department as of July 27th 2020. He is currently at top step Captains pay. Motion was called to a vote. Motion passed 5-0

A request for pension was received from Chief T.J Weidl under section 14-33 (Retirement for disabilities not connected with duties). Motion made by St.Hilaire and seconded by Kirkwood to accept his request for pension.

Under discussion - The question of procedure was brought up about a Chief requesting a pension and was addressed. The process of IME's was discussed also. Motion was called to a vote. Motion passed 4-0.
