

## LEGAL NOTICE AND OPPORTUNITY FOR PUBLIC COMMENT

### Second Amendment to Citizen Participation Plan

This is to notify all citizens that the City of Danbury plans to amend its Citizen Participation Plan for the Community Development Block Grant program. A five (5) day public-examination and comment period will begin on Thursday, December 17, 2020 and end on Monday, December 21, 2020, for the amendment to the City of Danbury Citizen Participation Plan.

- Effective December 17, 2020, consistent with the Mega-waiver issued by HUD on March 31, 2020 (exercised by the City of Danbury providing notification to HUD as prescribed on December 14, 2020), and for a period ending June 30, 2021, community input prior to drafting a substantial amendment to any City of Danbury plan will be provided in accordance with this amendment and the Mega-waiver, including an approved consolidated plan or annual action plan, concerning the proposed uses of CDBG funds.
- In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, the City of Danbury is amending its CDBG Citizen Participation Plan, to promote and support “social distancing” while continuing to offer the public an opportunity to provide valuable citizen input and insight, through virtual and other means, into the implementation of the Community Development Block Grant program. The City will accept electronic or written comment on this amendment and application through Monday, December 21, 2020 at [comments@danbury-ct.gov](mailto:comments@danbury-ct.gov), or mailed to: David St. Hilaire, Director of Finance, 155 Deer Hill Ave, Danbury, CT 06810. All comments received will be summarized with responses in the final version of the Amendment.
- In compliance with Executive Order 13166, and the City’s Language Access Plan, the City will arrange for an interpreter and assistance for non-English speaking residents.
